a. PROGRAM OFFICER (Deadline August 31, 2022)

Job Description

1. Assist the Program Manager in the implementation of the NAHI project.
2. Ensure that targets assigned on the project are met.
3. Ensure timely reporting of Activities on the project to DAPHO and the funder.
4. Ensure that records of project activities are kept up to date and accurately.
5. Oversee achievement of project goals and objectives.
6. Attend all internal and External Meetings on the project.
7. Oversee advocacy to stakeholders on the project.

Qualification and experience:

1. Must possess a HND or First Degree.
2. Must have at least 2 year of experience working in similar position.
3. Familiarity with the socio-cultural contexts of Gombe state will be an advantage.
4. Experience working with people who inject and/or are affected by injecting drug use is an added advantage.
5. Must have good interpersonal skills and emotional Intelligence.



b. Case Manager (Deadline: August 5, 2022)

Job Description:

1. Ensure the delivery of appropriate and qualitative HIV treatment for HIV positive clients.
2. Coordinate differentiated service delivery for HIV positive clients on the project.
3. Undertake case management responsibilities that include proactively managing a caseload (including elements of risk management), the monitoring, coordinating and review of care plans and ongoing service provision.
4. Assist field workers and other members on the project in achieving project objectives including conveying service users to treatment centre, perform other escort duties and home visits.
5. Ensure that records and user information are accurate, up to date, secure and maintained with regard at all times for the confidentiality.
6. Support peer support group meetings of HIV positive persons in a way that ensures they stay and treatment and improve behavior.
7. Support the mapping of service centres offering other relevant services for people in HIV treatment.

Qualifications / Experience:

1. Must possess qualifications in sociology, psychology, counseling, Nursing or any other health related field.
2. Must be empathic, a good listener and able to communicate in the local language (Hausa).
3. A minimum of two (2) years' experience in equivalent role in a hospital or an NGO.
4. Experience in a GF funded project on a similar role is an added advantage.
5. Applicants with lived experience of Drug Use or positively living with HIV will be given special consideration.
