Foster a safe, inclusive, and culturally sensitive learning environment for all participants.</li><li>3. Develop and tailor training materials to suit diverse learning needs and community contexts.</li><li>4. Support monitoring and evaluation by gathering participant feedback and compiling a post-training report.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Minimum of 3 years of proven experience facilitating SRHR trainings.</li><li>2. Demonstrated ability to work with marginalized groups, especially youth and PWID populations.</li><li>3. Strong knowledge of SRHR, gender-based violence prevention, and adolescent and community health.</li><li>4. Excellent communication and facilitation skills.</li><li>5. Fluency in English and Ibibio is an advantage.</li><li>6. Educational background in public health, social work, education, or a related field is preferred.</li></ol>
